Sub:- Preparation of Panel for appointment as Intelligence Officer in the offices of the Directorate of Revenue Intelligence at Kolkata, Berhampore, Guwahati, Silchar, Agartala, Aizwal and Imphal in the Pay Scale of Rs. 6500-200-10500- regarding.

The Kolkata Zonal Unit of the Directorate of Revenue Intelligence is in the process of drawing of panel of suitable candidates for filling up the vacancies/anticipated vacancies at Kolkata Zonal Unit, Berhampore Sub- Zonal Unit, Guwahati Regional Unit, Silchar Sub-Regional Unit, Imphal, Agartala and Aizwal Intelligence Cell.

It is proposed to fill up these vacancies by appointing on deputation basis, suitable officers with a minimum 3 (three) years of service in the grade of Inspector of Central Excise & Customs/ Preventive Officer/ Examiner of Customs. Officers who have been granted financial upgradation

under ACP scheme are also eligible for the said post. Deputation period will not ordinarily exceed 5 (five) years. However, on the basis of the officer's performance, deputation period can be extended upto a maximum 7 years. It may be made clear to the willing officers that option once exercised would be final and in the event of selection for posting as Intelligence Officer in the Directorate, they would not be allowed to withdraw their option.

The selected officers, while working in the Directorate in the grade of Intelligence Officer will be entitled to a special pay as admissible in pre-revised scale as per Ministry of Finance (DR)'s letter F. No. A-26011/ 32/ 98- AD.IIA dated 19.12.2002.

Further as per para IV of Ministry's Circular F. No. A-35017/28/92-AD.III-B dated 30.06.1994 officers posted in certain charges/ organization/ assignments are required to complete the "Cooling Off" period of not less than two years before posting in Directorate of Revenue Intelligence. However, the concerned Chief Commissioner of Customs/ Central Excise has been given the power to relax "Cooling Off" period.

It is requested that this circular may be brought to the notice of all the formations in your jurisdiction and the applications of willing officers forwarded to this office. While forwarding the names of the willing officers, the following information in respect of them may also be sent for evaluation by this Directorate.

1. Willingness of the Officer
2. CCR grading for the last 5 (five) years (duly verified and attested).
3. Vigilance clearance
4. No-objection to relieve the officer in the event of his selection.
5. History of posting.

The above information/ details may kindly be arranged to be furnished to this Directorate latest by 30-09-2008.
