Subject : Consolidated Instructions on compassionate appointment – Review
of FAQs dated 30.05.2013/25.02.2015 with regard to married son.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to enclosed herewith DOPT's OM No. 14014/02/12012-Estt.(D) dated 05.09.2016 on the subject above mentioned and to say that DOP&T has further reviewed the clarification/FAQ No. 13 dated 30.05.2013 and FAQ No. 60 dated 25.02.2015 in consultation with the Department of Legal Affairs and decided that married son can be considered for compassionate appointment if he otherwise fulfills all the other requirements of the Scheme i.e. he is otherwise eligible and fulfills the criteria laid down in this DOP&T O.M. dated 16th January, 2013. FAQ No. 13 dated 30.05.2013 and FAQ No. 60 dated 25.02.2015 has been withdrawn from the date of their issue by DOP&T.

2. The cases of compassionate appointment rejected solely on the grounds of marital status in terms of FAQ No. 13 dated 30.05.2013 during the intervening period i.e.w.e.f 30.05.2013 to 25.02.2015 in r/o married son may be reopened/reconsidered against vacancies occurring after issue of DOP&T's OM dated 05.09.2016.

3. Accordingly, All Cadre Controlling Units under Central Board of Excise & Customs are requested to scrupulously follow DOPT's instruction noted above for making appointments on compassionate grounds.
