Subject: Preparation of panel of Senior Intelligence Officers (SIOs)/ Intelligence Officers (IOs) cadres for posting on deputation/local transfer/loan basis in the Delhi Zonal Unit of Directorate General of Central Excise Intelligence.

The Delhi Zonal Unit of the Directorate General of Central Excise Intelligence is looking for suitable candidates to fill existing/ anticipated vacancies in the posts of SIOs and IOs at Delhi, Jaipur, Ludhiana and Rohtak on deputation/local rotational transfer/loan basis from amongst the officers of equivalent grades of Customs, Central Excise & Service Tax.

2. If selected and appointed on deputation basis, officers shall be entitled to Special Pay as defined in FR 9 (21) (a) (I) in the revised pay scale, subject to prescribed ceiling, as admissible. Normally, the deputation shall be for a period of five years, which may be extended by two years. In case of officer selected and appointed on local rotational transfer/loan basis, the initial appointment would generally be for a period of two years, which may be extended. In such cases the pay & allowances would be drawn by parent Commissionerate and there would not be entitlement to any special allowances/deputation allowance etc. In both the cases residential accommodation is not offered by DGCEI.

3. The Delhi Zonal Unit seeks to prepare panels for these officers which may be used over the year to fill vacancies . Hence, it is requested to please bring this to the notice of all formations in your jurisdiction. The applications of officers need to contain their willingness, location opted for, bio-data and history of postings. These are to be verified and attested along with APAR/ACR gradings for last 5 years and accompanied by Vigilance Clearance Certificate and a “No Objection Certificate” from Competent Authority for relieving the officer in the event of selection. The complete application set may be forwarded by the Chief Commissioner’s office. Meanwhile, the willing officer may send the advance copy of willingness, location opted for, bio-data and history of postings which would help in coordinating the matter.
