As you are aware, the 101st Amendment to the Constitution of India has created the legal framework for implementation of the Goods and Services Tax - a single indirect tax replacing a multitude of Central and State levies. The Government intends to introduce GST w.e.f. 1st April, 2017. For the benefit of departmental officers and members of trade and industry and public, CBEC has prepared the FAQs (Frequently Asked Questions) on GST, which was released by the Honourable Finance Minister on 21.9.2016. The FAQs on GST (available on CBEC website) has been widely appreciated.
